Spellings

Maths

Mrs Christopherson and Mrs Kingdon's group

We have been looking at adding and taking two-digit numbers mentally using different strategies e.g. rounding, adding units then tens and counting on if there's a small difference. Please use these strategies while playing on Education City's year 4 game Temple Crusade.

Mrs Taylor's group

This week we have been learning about rounding numbers to the nearest ten and hundred. Show what you understand about rounding numbers.

Rounding to nearest ten: if units digit is 1, 2, 3, 4—round down; 5, 6, 7, 8, 9—round up.

Rounding to nearest hundred: if the number ends in 49 or less, round down; 50 or more, round up.

Mr Webb's group

This week we have been looking at inverse operations for finding missing numbers and rounding for estimating answers. Give me examples of this to show your understanding.

Example = $1987 - ? = 400$
(inverse)

Example = $72 + 99 = ?$ (rounding)

English

Mrs Christopherson and Mrs Kingdon's group

We have been writing a thank you letter to the Iron Man for saving the world. Please can you show me your understanding of writing a letter to a book character of your choice. This needs to be set out correctly, properly punctuated and at least 3 paragraphs long.

Mrs Taylor's group

We have been writing letters to the Iron Man about ourselves. Please choose a book character of your own to write a letter to. Remember to use higher level punctuation, connectives and sentence openers and use the correct layout. Your letter should be at least 4 paragraphs long.

Mr Webb's group

We have been writing persuasive letters to the farmers of the Iron Man this week. I would like you to write your own persuasive letter to Hogarth who is the little boy in the Iron. The purpose of the letter will be to persuade Hogarth to come to our school and tell us about his adventures with the Iron Man. Make sure you use persuasive features and good reasons. Always remember your VCOP.

Topic
